In accordance with Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 reproduced as under:

"4A. Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB (Broad Specialities) with MD/MS & DNB (Super-Specialities) with DM/M.Ch.

(a) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in an institution which now runs MCI recognized postgraduate degree courses in a given subject, their DNB qualifications shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualifications in that subject only.

(b) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in a multi-speciality teaching hospital with at least 500 beds, involved in various postgraduate/super-speciality teaching programmes provided that the one out of three DNB supervisors (teachers) qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI norms in his/her previous appointment; and one out of remaining two should qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI regulations with the following bed requirement for teaching unit:

Postgraduate Broad Specialities 30 beds per unit } 50% beds should be teaching beds.
Postgraduate Super Specialities 20 beds per unit }

Such a qualification shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualification.

(c) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training in both Broad Specialities and Super-Specialities course in other locations/institutions (100 or more bedded hospitals) shall work for one additional year as a senior resident in a MCI recognized/permitted institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

(d) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training or after possessing DNB qualification, in both Broad Specialities and Super-Specialities course from an institution not covered in sub-clauses (a) to (c) shall work for two additional years as Sr. Resident/Research Associate (CSIR) in an MCI recognised/permitted medical college/institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

BOND: Candidates selected for Post-Doctoral Fellowship will execute a bond of ₹ 2,00,000/- (Two Lakh Rupees Only) on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of ₹ 100/- along with 2 sureties.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

Eligible applicants will be notified to appear in an exam (MCQs based) followed by an Interview. Shortlisting of candidates will be done in ratio of 1:6 per vacancy, according to marks obtained in the exam.

THE SELECTION CRITERIA:

- a). 80% weightage – Examination (MCQs based)
- b). 20% weightage – Interview

FILLING OF MORE THAN ONE APPLICATION / DUPLICATION APPLICATION FORM:

No candidate is allowed to fill more than one application against the Seat /Department/ Subject.

Duplicate applications form from any applicant will result in cancellation of all such applications. No intimation regarding such rejections will be given to the candidate a registration fees submitted against subject application will automatically be forfeited.

Requirement for admission of "SPONSORED" Candidates

a) Candidates who are permanent employees of any Central/State Government/Armed Forces or the Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body can be sponsored by the respective Government/Defense Authorities or the Competent Authorities of PSU/Autonomous Body.

b) A State Government can sponsor candidates only for those Fellowship Programme which are not available in that State. A certificate regarding non-availability of the Fellowship (for which the candidate is being sponsored) in the concerned State, duly signed by the Secretary/Director General of Health Services of the Central / State Government/ DGAFMS/Competent Authority or PSU/Autonomous Body viz. The Director/Executive Head of the concerned organization, should be furnished in the format prescribed for this purpose.

c) All eligible "sponsored" candidates will be called by the Institute for an entrance test.

d) Seats as shown in the advertisement are available for "sponsored" candidates. Sponsored candidate will be designated as "Fellow".

e) The subject for which the candidate is being sponsored should be clearly specified in the sponsorship form by the sponsoring authority. The candidate can be sponsored for only one subject. Applications from candidates sponsored for more than one subject will not be considered.

f) No "Sponsored" candidate will be paid any emoluments to the Institute during the training period. Such payments will be the responsibility of the sponsoring authority (i.e. Central/State Government or Defense Authorities).

g) It is mandatory to upload a valid "Sponsorship certificate" on or before last date of submission of application form. However, the candidate must submit/send a sponsorship certificate in original from their employers in the following format along with the application form to the Office of Dean (Academics), 2nd Floor, Medical College, AIIMS, Jodhpur-342005.

WRITTEN EXAM & INTERVIEW:

The examination and interview will be conducted at AIIMS, Jodhpur. A separate notice regarding schedule of examination and interview will be uploaded on the institute's website.
