Project Description

The project is an assessment aimed at locating the progress towards empowerment of women and men in Maharashtra towards a more gender equal state and society. It will explore and bring out the gender transformatory work that has been done so far by the state and based on the findings suggest ways to deepen and build on the existing work being done by about 13 departments of the government. Gender approaches are several and it is significant to locate which ones lead to changes in gender relations and actual transformation, create enabling conditions for women and some men from challenged backgrounds to participate fully in the development of the society and the country. The project will use the IFAD the Gender Transformative Mechanism in the context of Climate Adaptation (GTM) to explore and analyse policies and legislative (national, subnational, local), specifically, gender responsive budgeting in departments of agriculture, dairy farming, labour, environment and climate change, Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Planning Dept, industry, education, energy and marketing and cooperatives, which are gender responsive or create barriers within livelihood programmes, health, and related sectors,. It will entail desk reviews of government documents, interviews with select government personnel and district level officials in the sampled districts.
